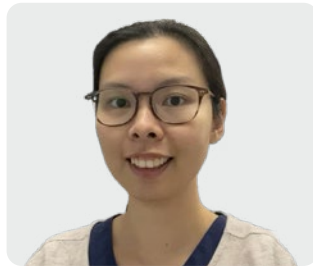

## Venue

The Congress will take place at the Hyatt Regency Sydney, located at 161 Sussex Street, Sydney NSW 2000. Positioned on the edge of Darling Harbour in the heart of Sydney's CBD, the hotel offers modern congress facilities and expansive event spaces overlooking the harbour.

The Hyatt Regency Sydney is well connected to the wider Sydney area. Wynyard and Town Hall train stations are both within walking distance, providing convenient access to Circular Quay, Central Station, and other major parts of the city. Light rail, taxi, and rideshare services are also readily available nearby, with designated pick-up and drop-off points located at the hotel entrance.

Sydney Airport (Kingsford Smith) is approximately 9 km from the venue, with an average travel time of 20–25 minutes depending on traffic conditions. Delegates arriving from interstate or overseas may wish to pre-book airport transfers or allow extra travel time during peak periods.

The venue is also within easy walking distance of many of Sydney's key waterfront attractions, including Darling Harbour, Barangaroo, King Street Wharf dining precinct, and the International Congress Centre Sydney, as well as a wide range of restaurants, shopping areas, and entertainment venues. Inside the venue, delegates will find the Congress session rooms and meeting spaces located within the hotel's dedicated Congress and exhibition levels. Signage will be placed throughout the venue to guide attendees to session rooms, social functions, restrooms, and exhibition areas.

### Venue Acknowledgement

## Transport

### Public transport

The nearest major train station is Town Hall Station, approximately a five-minute walk from the hotel.

Light rail stops and ferry terminals are also within easy walking distance, including King Street Wharf, which is around a nine-minute walk away.

Several bus services operate nearby, with stops located on Sussex Street after King Street and Kent Street after Market Street.

### Airport access

The hotel is approximately 8 km from Sydney Airport. Transport options include taxi, rideshare services such as Uber or DiDi, and public transport. The Airport Link train provides a direct connection to the city, with Town Hall Station located a short walk from the hotel.

**Parking**– The hotel does not operate a dedicated on-site parking facility. The nearest option is Wilson Parking at 168 Sussex Street (entry via 168 Sussex Street or 383 Kent Street), located opposite the hotel.

Height restrictions apply, with a maximum clearance of 2.1 metres at the Sussex Street entrance.

Indicative rates for a 24-hour multi-entry pass are approximately AUD \$80 Sunday to Thursday and AUD \$50–\$55 Friday to Saturday, when booked via the hotel or affiliated arrangements.

As parking in the CBD is in high demand, pre-booking is recommended where possible, and delegates should allow additional time for arrival.

### Dr Tim Keys

**Paediatric Dentist at Children's Dental Centre**

Dr Keys is a Paediatric Dentist located on the Sunshine Coast and regional Queensland. He works in both private and public sectors and is passionate about helping practitioners provide the best care they can to their paediatric patients.

Dr Sharonne Zaks AM is a dentist with more than 25 years of experience and a leading voice in trauma-informed dental care. Many families travel from across Australia to seek her compassionate, safe, and patient-centred approach.

Drawing on trauma-informed principles, clinical experience, and ongoing research into anxiety, phobia, and trauma, Dr Zaks helps clinicians better understand how early experiences shape dental behaviour. Her work provides dental teams with practical frameworks to create emotionally safe environments, reduce distress, and support long-term positive oral health outcomes for vulnerable patients of all ages.

Dr Zaks' groundbreaking contributions have been featured by the ABC, BBC, SBS, and The Age, and her insights appear in widely distributed publications, with inclusion in a forthcoming global textbook underway. In 2019, she delivered an influential talk at TEDx Sydney on trauma-informed care in dentistry. Her professional achievements include two international fellowships, the ADA Dentistry Achievement Award, and her appointment as a Member of

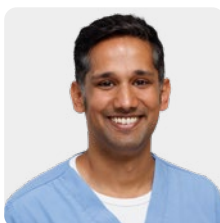
### Prof Alex Broom

**Professor of Sociology Director, Sydney Centre for Healthy Societies. Global Leader in Health Sociology**

Alex Broom is Academic Director (Social, Behavioural & Economic Sciences) at the Australian Research Council. He is also Professor of Sociology and Director of the Sydney Centre for Healthy Societies, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, The University of Sydney.

He is recognised as an international leader in sociology, with a specific interest in health, illness and care. His work takes a person-centred approach, qualitatively exploring the intersections of individual experience and social, political and economic context. His career has been dedicated to building inclusive, interdisciplinary research communities and translating scholarship into meaningful outcomes for policy, industry, and society. He founded the Sydney Centre for Healthy Societies, a Flagship Centre of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences at The University of Sydney.

Over the course of his career, and working in partnership with community, government and industry, he has led or co-led over \$30 million in social science research projects, including 16 Australian Research Council (ARC) projects and an ARC Future Fellowship.effective, and child-centred dentistry.



### Dr Harry Mohan

**Endodontist with Expertise in Dental Trauma**

Dr Harry Mohan is a specialist endodontist in private practice in Sydney and a Senior Lecturer at the University of Sydney and Honorary Lecturer at the University of Puthisastra, Cambodia. He has a strong clinical and academic focus on clinical endodontics, dental trauma and the care of patients experiencing dental fear and anxiety.

After completing his Bachelor of Dental Science at the University of Melbourne in 2008, Dr Mohan began his career as a Dental Officer in the Royal Australian Air Force. He returned to the University of Melbourne and completed his Doctor of Clinical Dentistry in Endodontics in 2015 and has been in private practice in NSW since. Dr Mohan is passionate about endodontic education and in addition to his university positions, he is a regular presenter of dental CPD across Australia. He is an active member of the Australian Society of Endodontology, the Australian and New Zealand Academy of Endodontists, and the Australian Dental Association, and in 2022 founded Dental Aid: CPD for a Cause, an annual not-for-profit CPD event which helps establish incomes for families living in poverty in Asia. Dr Mohan brings a collaborative, clinically focused perspective that supports dentists in delivering safe, effective, and contemporary endodontic care for young patients.

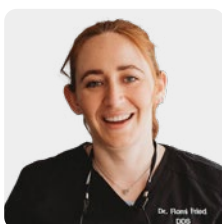


### Dr Blessy John-Denny

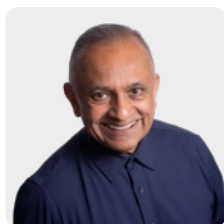

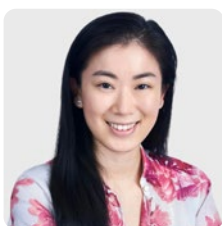
### Dr Emilija Jensen

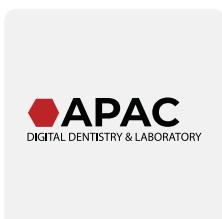

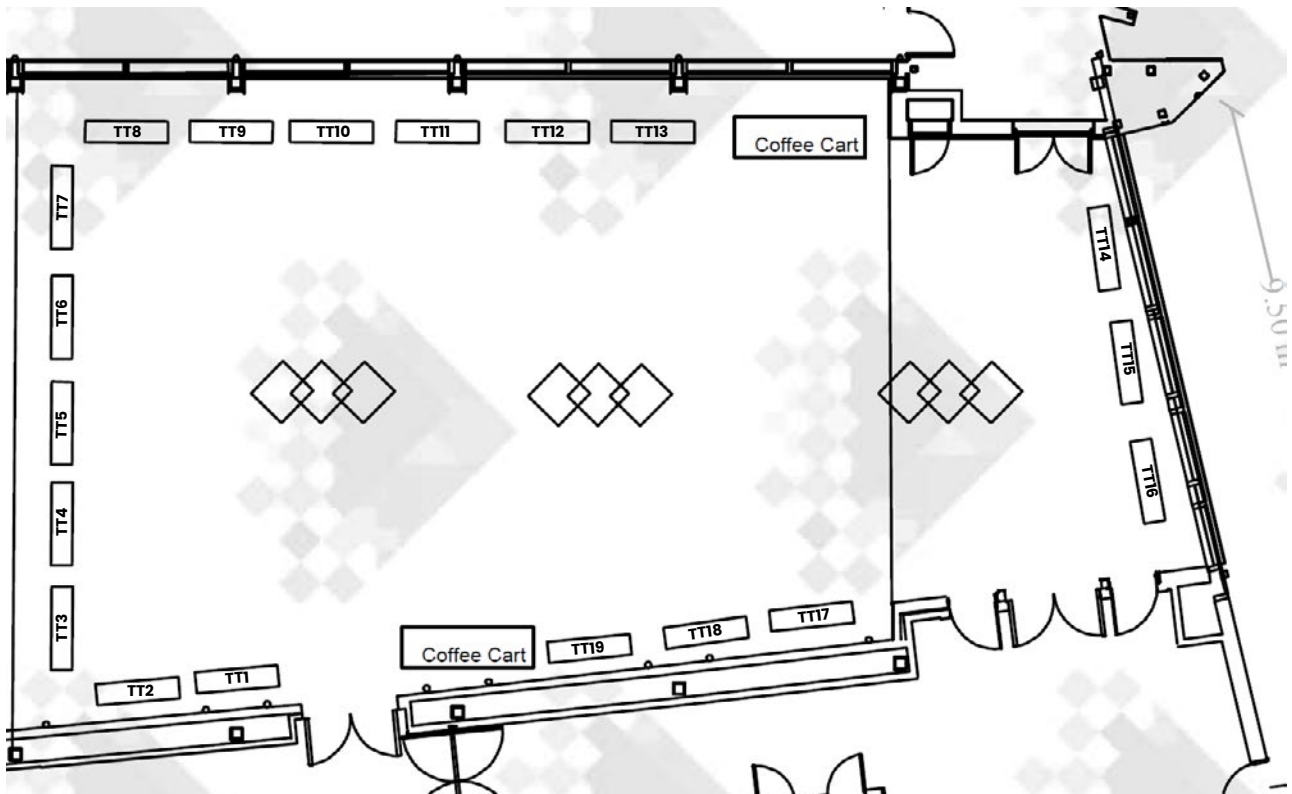
